## Recent Water Use Trends

During March and April, the latest period for which we have data, total water usage by Belmont Terrace residents increased significantly – about 40 percent – over last year.

This is probably attributable to the fact that we have had less rainfall this year and the air temperatures have been warmer. (Plus, many of us have spent more time at home because of the coronavirus lockdown.) Nevertheless, it underscores the need for continual water conservation because we are just now getting into the summer months when water use typically peaks.

We want to thank the two residents who recently agreed to modify their irrigation schedules to avoid excessive water use and runoff. And we urge all residents to monitor their systems and reduce water use whenever possible.

Though our well does not seem to be in any danger of running low, we do have to meet state standards for adequate water storage capacity based on how much we use. Last summer, we came very close to exceeding the amount that would trigger a requirement that we add storage capacity – at significant expense to us all.

## Emergency Response Committee

This January, Claire Schlecht volunteered to fill the role as our Emergency Response Committee (ERC) Leader. She has been very efficient in working with the Board and water operators to guide our block captains in posting recent water Alerts and Notices.

Claire works full time as Executive Assistant at Tanium and is relatively new to the neighborhood. She and her fiancé, Cole, moved into 974 Dorthel in February of 2019. While Cole grew up in nearby Forestville, Claire originally hails from Louisiana, but she's really taken to Sebastopol. They have six cats, five chickens and a fair-sized garden. ## Tank Cleaning & Re-roofing

The Board is still looking at options for cleaning and re-roofing our water storage tank. Recent inspections have shown that there isn't much sediment accumulation in the tank, so there is no urgency about draining and cleaning it. We are going ahead with re-roofing the operations building to deal with some small leaks.

## Repair of Leaking Street Valve

In April, our operators arranged for the repair of a leaking valve in the main line on Dorthel Street. The repair was successfully completed on time and within the budget. Routine repairs like this are fairly common in an old system like ours, so it is important not only that we maintain a “rainy day” fund to finance them, but also that we anticipate potential problems and upgrade the system when necessary.
